



## **Group Fees and Program Definitions**

Effective October 1, 2006

At The History Center in Tompkins County, we put history at your fingertips. Our informative and customized learning experiences are appropriate for students, youth, and adults. The following fees are charged to help offset the costs involved in producing these programs.

### **Workshops**

---

#### **Hands-on History Workshops: \$65**

Professionally guided, hands-on tours of current exhibitions, behind the scenes activities, and pre-determined local history subject matter.

1 – 1.5 hours; 20 person maximum (not including chaperones at a 1:10 ratio)

#### **Customized History Workshop: \$175**

Professionally designed learning experience based on the interests of the group.

Can be designed around a particular aspect of the collection or theme in local history

1 – 1.5 hours; 20 person maximum

### **Eight Square Schoolhouse**

---

#### **Eight Square Schoolhouse Living History Program: \$200**

This day-long learning experience provides children with the opportunity to experience a day in a rural one-room historic schoolhouse as if it were 1892.

25 student maximum not including chaperones.

Class runs approximately 8:30am – 1:30pm

#### **Eight Square Schoolhouse Group Tour: \$50**

One-hour mini-class designed for ADULT groups led by our teacher-interpreters

1 – 1.5 hours; 25 person maximum

### **Research Library**

---

#### **Introduction to Historical Research: \$75 plus per person fee of \$5**

Orientation to the historical resources available at The History Center, led by Education and Archives staff. Depending upon the experience level of the group, the orientation may include teaching about primary and secondary sources, and the best methods for acquiring historical information. One time per-person fee includes personal assistance for each participant as they complete their research project. Designed for adult and college-level groups.

#### **Youth Research Groups: \$30 per hour, plus \$3 per person fee**

For student groups of more than 3 persons interested in researching a specific theme. Whenever possible, groups will be scheduled during non-public hours so that the full attention of our Research Assistants and the full resources of our Research Library can be made available.
