COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

Scholar, educator, and community benefactor, Dr. Sean Eversley Bradwell currently serves as the Director of Programs and Outreach at Ithaca College. His career spans academia at many levels, including time as a teacher at Ithaca's Lehman Alternative Community School, and recently as an Assistant Professor at Ithaca College's Center for the Study of Culture, Race and Ethnicity. His PhD. (from Cornell) is in policy analysis and management and his areas of specialty include Race Theory, Hip Hop Culture and Educational Policy.

In addition to the work he does teaching, researching, writing, lecturing, and moderating and participating on scholarly panels, he also contributes to the local community, giving his time, energy, and talent in many ways. Perhaps his most visible contribution is his six plus years as a member of the Ithaca City School Board of Education, where he is chairman of both the Education Policy Committee and Education Facilities Committee.

This collection contains materials on Dr. Eversley Bradwell's professional life, especially his work at Ithaca College, and the ICSD School Board. It also contains materials on general education issues, especially as affecting students of color. It also highlights the lives and work of other notable local African Americans.
